Seventeen years ago, Jasper and Carolyn Bacon, founders of In His Steps Ministries, reached out to the Saw Mill Quarters providing Vacation Bible School and minor home renovations, in conjunction with partnering churches. However, IHS wanted to do more. IHS hosted monthly family oriented recreational activities in the Saw Mill over the last few months. The Saw Mill is a close knit, yet challenged community, just east of the IHS property line. The intent of this outreach is to be an inspiration of love and hope for it residents. During the recent event, the neighborhood enjoyed fellowship, music, food, sports and games. More importantly, the gospel was presented and several young adults responded to the gospel message. The outreach attracted approximately 100 children and 45 adults, who enjoyed all of what the event had to offer.

The projected goal, in conjunction with partnering churches, is to develop a holistic ministry in the Saw Mill Quarters including Christ-centered early childhood development, young adult empowerment, sports and recreation ministry and economic development, to promote growth and success for its residents.
